




Current Wait Times

Underserved

- 38%tile vs. other Main Line Health areas (70%tile) suggest a supply gap of clinicians and appointments

 Our engineers and traffic planners know the code requirements and have developed recommendations that meet or exceed all requirements.

 PennDOT is considering a few options for changes to the Route 30 bypass and the interchange onto Manor Avenue.

• The location of our building would not be impacted by any of the alternatives that PennDOT has put forth. Meaning, we would be building on what each alternative indicates would not be where they intend to lay roadway.

 We are asking the township for a zoning change. The property is currently in R2 residential, and we are seeking a reclassification as C2 commercial.



Traffic Study

RECOMMENDATIONS

| Intersection | Recommendation |
|---|---|
| Manor Avenue (SR 0322) & Rock Raymond Road (SR 4017) | Install a NB Approach consisting of a Left Turn Lane and Thru-Right Turn Lane, to form the fourth leg of the existing T-intersection. The fourth leg will act as the site driveway under 2027 Conditions and will act as the G O Carlson Boulevard Extension in 2032. |
| | Widen the SB Approach to provide separate Left, Thru and Right turn lanes. |
| | Restripe the existing gore area on the WB Approach to provide a 105' dedicated Left-Turn Lane followed by the continuation of the existing two-way center left turn lane. |
| | Add an advance Left turn phase to the WB approach to match the existing EB advance phase. |
| | Provide a 175' deceleration lane on the EB approach to the site driveway. |
| Manor Avenue (SR 0322) & Lloyd Avenue | As an interim improvement, restripe the NB approach to consist of a NB Left Turn Lane and a NB Thru-Right Turn Lane under the 2027 conditions. |
| Manor Avenue (SR 0322) & EB Route 30 Ramps (Improvements to be completed by PennDOT as part of the Route 30 By- Pass Project) | Under 2032 conditions, PennDOT proposes to signalize this intersection based on Improvement Alternative A. |
| G O Carlson Boulevard & Lloyd Avenue (Improvements to be completed by PennDOT as part of the Route 30 By- Pass Project) | Under 2032 conditions, switch the NB/SB approaches to stop controlled and the EB/WB approaches to free. |
| | TPD suggests the addition of a WB Left Turn Lane and NB Right Turn Lane as part of PennDOT's Route 30 By-Pass Project |
| Manor Avenue (SR 0322) & Lancaster Avenue (SR 3070) Corridors | Optimize study area traffic signal timings. |

^{*}Collaborative process between Main Line Health, Caln Township and PennDOT to develop a roadway improvement package that addresses not only existing traffic operations but also mitigates the impact of the proposed development.



Timeline
